

# Calgary's Mustard Seed building gets go-ahead nod

Calgary's Mustard Seed Street Ministry will begin planning a groundbreaking ceremony after the Calgary City Planning Commission approved an application for a 19-storey affordable housing building in Beltline.

The building will hold 228-low rent apartments for single men and women as well as retail space and support services. The building, says Mustard Seed executives, is an important step in helping Calgarians overcome homelessness.

The Mustard Seed has already secured funding from the province and more funders have expressed interest in donating as the planning and construction proceeds.

A groundbreaking story is expected to be held in the spring of 2010.
